Dear Sir:

Reference road-yard seniority consolidation agreements covering Kansas City, St. Louis and Little Rock areas, as well as some of the smaller road-yard districts.

The above mentioned agreements provide that employees may elect to exercise their seniority from road to yard or from yard to road with the exception that employees who elect to move from one class of service to another must remain in the class of service in which they place themselves, seniority permitting, for a period of not less than sixty (60) days.

However, it is agreed that employees in the consolidated St. Louis seniority district who move from road to yard or from yard to road will remain in the class of service in which they place themselves, seniority permitting, for a period of not less than thirty (30) days.

This understanding is subject to cancellation by either party serving fifteen (15) days written notice upon the other of its intent to cancel.
