Dear Chairpersons:

Pursuant to the provisions of the July 1, 2008 National Agreement, existing rates of pay will be adjusted effective January 1, 2011 by a \$0.03 cost-of-living allowance (COLA).

Attached for information you will find a copy of the January 1, 2011 rate sheets reflecting the COLA adjustment.

Additionally, the employee contribution toward the cost of H&W benefits will also be adjusted pursuant to the July 1, 2008 agreement. Effective January 1, 2011 the employee contribution will be increased to \$202.90 for operating craft employees (Document "A") and \$202.71 for the yardmaster craft (Document "B").

The slight difference in the contribution amount is due to difference in the 2009 Average Straight-Time Equivalent hours component of the formula used in determining the contribution amount.
